

Planned Site/Playground Upgrades Update

- Fitness park Build scheduled for next holidays Funding from Community Building Partnership Grant 2020 (\$50,000) + P&C funds (\$20,000)
- Metro Renewal Program Resurfacing of Courts and building retaining walls and pathway behind OoSH - Scoping and Final costings currently taking place - Funding from Metro Renewal program = \$45,000 + Schools Funds = \$30,000
- 2 x Operable Walls approved 12-16week installation
- OoSH Hub Update handover has taken place waiting for cleaning contract to be adjusted. We will commence use from next Monday. OoSH program will occupy once regulatory authority has approved space – mid-term. Furniture fit out and landscaping being undertaken by Primary OoSHCare
- Palace Upgrade will be completed this week occupy by APs during next week.
- Lock Replacement Program completed
- STEM Room upgrade will commence once OoSH program relocate to new building.
- Ongoing technology upgrades new iPads
- Upcoming Community Building Partnership Grant 2021 Application pending to install landscaping along the side of the tennis courts in Infant's play area as per the overall school plan. Expected install 2022. Funding from Community Building Partnership Grant 2021 (\$50,000) + P&C funds (\$25,000)
