

A big THANK YOU to the P&C and all volunteers for all the work that's gone into recent fundraising.

NAPLAN: We're nearly done! It's an assessment that gives the school good quality information however now it is online it has blown out from a 3 day to a 2 week process due to finite resources to access computers. Unfortunately

results take up to 3 months. School has been working on improving achievement in results but they are working from a high base. Mr Holmes has offered to do a presentation once we get the results.

Alison: What is the reason that we don't get test results when our children participate in an exam (EG Maths).

Mrs Taylor: Assessment is more broad than an exam and some of the richest learning is across a breadth of interactions. Learning is not converted to a mark but rather looks at a continuum of progression for the child's learning.
