

- CT Was concerned about the left over carnival mess from the pre-package items. This was a bad look for the school. Felt that there need to be a look at what is sold as it distracts kids from participating
- ST The children will be occupied the whole time, so the problems with canteen distraction and mess will be minimised. There is only the recess break
- LH The feeling is that K-2 preference is cakes/BBQ with chips but not lollies and sweet stuff, but dependent on C19 rules at time

Note: No objections were raised

- LH Concern about littering at carnivals
- GH Was not pleased. Felt clean up was poorly organised and accepted responsibility. Was a bad look for community.
- AM Said that the items offered had been broadened because of C19 restrictions.
- LH The preference is for food and not sweets
- CM We had to use pre-packaged because of C19 rules
- CT Asked why Zone events are not following the same C19 rules?
- GH This relies on advice received from Dept and Covid Task Force going forward.

Maybe we should look at a food policy since lollies etc are out of step with messaging about healthy food and dental hygiene

AM – Then asked about school canteen selling 'junk food'

GH – Canteen is controlled to the area health rules and are allowed to sell controlled measures of 'red + orange' as well as 'green' food

LH – Noted that the kids stayed out of the disco itself in the main till the canteen closed. To counter balance nonsale of lollies the price of the disco would need to rise

CM – The participation at the carnival was not high enough. Events need to be reviewed

LH – There weren't novelty events to cater for the noncompetitive kids

AD - Canteen interferes with events

GH – Said they got a great attendance rate overall for BHNPS kids

LH – Review of food sold as an agenda item at next meeting for discussion

LH-GH - Discussed the absence of war cries.

	To Hills Shire Council,	
	I'm writing on behalf of the Baulkham Hills North Public School P&C. It has come to our attention that, following the upgrade of facilities, the pricing for our school to hold its yearly swimming carnival has increased significantly.	
	Prior to renovation, the school was charged \$450 for the day to hold the swimming carnival at Waves Baulkham Hills. This has now increased to \$3000. While we understand that the improvements to the site incurred significant cost to council, it is disappointing that an increase of six times has been imposed on a local public school in the Hills Shire.	
	I'm seeking a response from the council as to whether there is an opportunity for the private operator to reduce the costs for our school, noting that our parents are also the most likely to privately pay for swim school and pool entry use.	
	I look forward to hearing what arrangements Council may have considered for Public Schools to ensure access to these facilities remain available to all via their swimming carnival.

The \$450 you were charged equates to \$75 per hour for a standard 6 hour carnival, this is not a fee we would be able to offer your school. The Council adopted school carnival hire fees are inclusive of student entry/school
