On a device via the Sentral for Parents App – Newsfeed function

- 3. To open this notification, click on the 'Newsfeed' tile
- 4. Here you will be able to open the report
- 5. On most devices you will be unable to save the file through this method. You will need to open the file in a web browser such as Chrome or Safari

On a device via the Sentral for Parents App – Portal Function

- 2. Click on the 'Portal' tile
- 3. Here you will see any notifications sent through from the school
- 4. Swipe from the left side of the screen to the right. This will display the portal menu
- 5. Click on your child's name
- 6. Click on 'Student Details' or swipe from the right side of the screen to the left. This will display your child's photo and class details
- 7. Click on '+Published Reports'
- 8. Click on Semester 1, 2020 to view the report
